THE TILTING WORLD (1996 - 2016)

The exhibit *The Tilting World (1996-2016)* gathers twenty years of artistic works by Montrealer photographer Alain Lefort. Punctuated by major series, this exhibit offers to the eye strangely familiar landscapes.

Alain Lefort integrates in his practice traditions from analogical photography and technology from digital photography. He favors the themes of the landscape as a linchpin to manipulate or divert from the photographic material. At times, the use of outdated films, papers or damaged camera bodies blurs the line between representation and intervention. The refined images thus meet the alternated or rebuilt landscapes.
